<i>Archives of Disease in Childhood-Fetal & Neonatal Edition</i>	Systematic reviews and meta-analyses: PRISMA guidelines and MOOSE guidelines; also refers to Equator network
<i>Journal of Adolescent Health</i>	Nothing specific for SRs
<i>Pediatric Infectious Disease Journal</i>	Nothing specific for SRs
<i>Pediatric Allergy & Immunology</i>	Nothing specific for SRs
<i>Pediatric Research</i>	Should be formatted according to PRISMA guidelines
