Guiding questions for follow-up phone interviews

8. Do you know if students are licensing products directly? If so, do you know about how much they pay annually?
9. What, if anything, might prompt you to consider licensing these types of resources?
10. How do you think libraries will be thinking about or dealing with these types of resources in, say, five years?
